AT MULTIPLE CENTERS

Rhinebeck, NY – April 11, 2017 – To increase availability options and meet the high demand for services, Astor Services for Children & Families in Rhinebeck and throughout the Hudson Valley, is expanding its intake hours at its area counseling centers. Across multiple locations, the organization's hundreds of employees will now be available to take walk-ins at its clinics.

The following counseling center locations are expanding their intake walk-in times: Poughkeepsie, Hyde Park, Kingston, New Paltz, Ellenville, Beacon and Dover. Typically, the times run Monday through Thursday, 9 a.m. to 5p.m., with variations depending on the location.
