



Residential Treatment Center

Astor's Residential Treatment Center (RTC) serves children who have difficulty safely managing their emotions. Children at the RTC have tried all of the services offered

in their community and have had many psychiatric inpatient hospitalizations.

These children may have also had unpleasant experiences or trauma in their lives. The RTC provides a higher level of mental health care so each child can reach their goals and excel in all areas of life.

Referral Criteria:

- Children must be between the ages of 5 – 13
- Need more emotional and behavioral support than their community environment can provide

Referral Sources:

- Local departments of Social Services,
- The child's home school district Committee on Special Education (CSE)

Services:

- Evaluation by child psychiatrist
- Individual & group therapy
- Family support, education, and therapy
- Ongoing medication treatment
- Physical health
- 24/7 nursing

- Crisis prevention/intervention
- Case management
- Room and board
- 24/7 supervision by trained child care professionals
- Therapeutic educational environment through the Astor Learning Center
- Specialized Developmental Abilities Services (DAS) designation
- Recreational activities
- Discharge planning
