



High Fidelity Wraparound Program

The High Fidelity Wraparound (HFW) is an evidence-based model of care coordination that uses a highly structured, team-based, family-centered management process.

The process involves intensive, individualized planning and managing for children and youth (ages 6-21) with serious social, emotional, or behavioral concerns or two Mental Health diagnosis.

The youth must be involved in multiple child service systems, such as behavioral health, child welfare, juvenile justice, and special education.

The family is provided with weekly services from the HFW Care Manager who will in partnership with the youth and family, build a team of community providers who can best impact and provide support to the challenges being faced.

In utilizing this wrap-around approach, several positive outcomes are possible such as sustained familial cohesion and stabilization, improved academic performance, and lower rates of hospitalization and residential treatment.
