Hickey Center (LRS) Universal Pre-K Early Childhood Programs	Promotes school readiness of children from zero to age five from low-income families by enhancing their cognitive, social, and emotional development. These services include center-based classrooms, special education, and home visiting.	Bronx, Dutchess
Mental Health Outpatient Treatment and Rehabilitative Services Mental Health Outpatient Treatment and Rehabilitative Services	Provide evidence based, trauma-informed individual and family therapy to help children manage emotional and behavioral difficulties in their local community. Astor Learning Center (ALC) School Based Programs	Provides services to students ages 5 through 14 who are experiencing emotional and educational challenges. Students reside at home while attending a more structured educational program. All students receive support to help them return successfully to their local districts. Day Treatment School Based Programs	Provides long-term clinical treatment and education to youth with serious behavioral difficulties in a school setting.	Bronx, Dutchess, Ulster
School Based Behavioral Health & Training (SBBHT) School Based Programs	Provides skill building, treatment, case management and other support services for children and their families in their local school.	Bronx, Dutchess, Ulster
Care Management Home & Community Based Programs	Provides care coordination to Health Home eligible children. A care manager links, supports, and oversees access to services/systems a child and family may need to improve overall health.	Dutchess, Orange, Putnam, Rockland, Sullivan, Ulster, Westchester
Enhanced Coordinated Children Services Initiative (ECCSI) Home & Community Based Programs	A multi-agency process that seeks to prevent out-of-home placement and coordinate services to meet the family's complex needs in Dutchess County.	Dutchess
High Fidelity Wrap Around Home & Community Based Programs	Evidence-based care coordination that uses a highly structured, team-based, family-centered approach to offer children & adolescents a positive outcome. The process involves intensive, individualized planning and managing for children and youth (ages 12-21) with serious social, emotional, or behavioral concerns. Home Based Crisis Intervention (HBCI) Home & Community Based Programs	Provides short-term crisis support and treatment for children and their families to avoid a higher level of care.	Dutchess, Ulster
Partial Hospitalization Home & Community Based Programs	Provides short-term clinical services to adolescents in danger of needing a higher level of care or transitioning from a higher level of care.	Dutchess, Ulster, Orange, Rockland
Prevention Home & Community Based Programs	Helps to keep families together and children safe through provision of home-based skill building and crisis intervention services.	Bronx, Dutchess, Orange
Serving Youth in their Community (SYNC) Home & Community Based Programs	Offers a wide array of home, school, and community-based services tailored to meet the behavioral and emotional health needs of each child with their family's voice and wishes at the forefront of service delivery.	Bronx, Dutchess
Residential Treatment Center (RTC) Residential Treatment Facility (RTF) Residential Program	Provides therapeutic services in a nurturing environment to children with serious mental health and behavioral concerns. The needs of the children and their families are met through a program model that is family centered and trauma informed.	Dutchess, Orange, Putnam, Rockland, Sullivan, Ulster, Westchester
Therapeutic Foster Boarding Home Residential Program	Combines the best of traditional foster care with a progressive model that creates a supportive therapeutic environment for the child. This is an ideal step-down program for a child in residential care.	Hudson Valley
