

Contact Breakfast to feature keynote from Dutchess Tourism President and CEO

The Dutchess County Regional Chamber of Commerce will host the August Contact Breakfast on Wednesday, August 21, at 7:30 a.m. at Double Tree by Hilton, 40 Civic Center Plaza in Poughkeepsie.

This month's breakfast will feature a keynote presentation from the President and CEO of Dutchess Tourism, Melaine Rottkamp.

Melaine Rottkamp is a certified destination management executive who has worked passionately since 2011 to support and highlight more than 1,200 tourism-related businesses and organizations in all parts of Dutchess County.

In her role as President and CEO, she employs data-driven strategies to oversee Dutchess Tourism's advertising and marketing campaigns, positioning the county as a premier destination for both leisure and business travelers. These efforts attract visitors from around the world, resulting in nearly \$2 million dollars per day in visitor spending for local businesses and attractions. This substantial economic impact also contributes \$88 million in local and state taxes, which are reinvested into the community.

Melaine also leads Dutchess Tourism's business support and outreach initiatives, which encompass workforce development programs, educational seminars, conferences, networking opportunities, and recognition events. She directs the activities of Film Dutchess in collaboration with the Hudson Valley Film Commission, driving productions and economic investment that totaled \$53 million in direct spending for the region last year.

A sought-after speaker, Melaine shares her expertise at regional, state, and international tourism conferences, offering successful strategies and fostering collaborations among destination organizations and tourism businesses.

This summer, Dutchess Tourism's exceptional efforts were honored with three Tourism Excellence Awards from the New York State Tourism Industry Association, recognizing their achievements in marketing, business support, and visitor services programs.


